

CERTIFICATION


The undersigned officer of Vitens NV (“Vitens”), being duly authorized to represent and speak on behalf of Vitens, hereby state to the best of my knowledge and belief, as follows:

Vitens understands the State of Illinois’ policy as expressed in Section 5/1-110.6 of the Illinois Pension Code (“the Statute”) to restrict investment by its pension funds in Iran-restricted companies, Sudan-restricted companies and companies that boycott Israel. Under the Statute “boycott Israel” means “engaging in actions that are politically motivated and are intended to penalize, inflict economic harm on, or otherwise limit commercial relations with the State of Israel or companies based in the State of Israel or territories controlled by the State of Israel.”

Vitens certifies that it does not engage in actions that boycott Israel as that term is defined in the Statute. Vitens further states that any allegations that Vitens is engaged in a boycott of Israel (including as a result of pressure from others to boycott Israel) are false.

To the best of my knowledge and belief, I certify under penalty of perjury that the statements set forth in this instrument are true and correct.
